



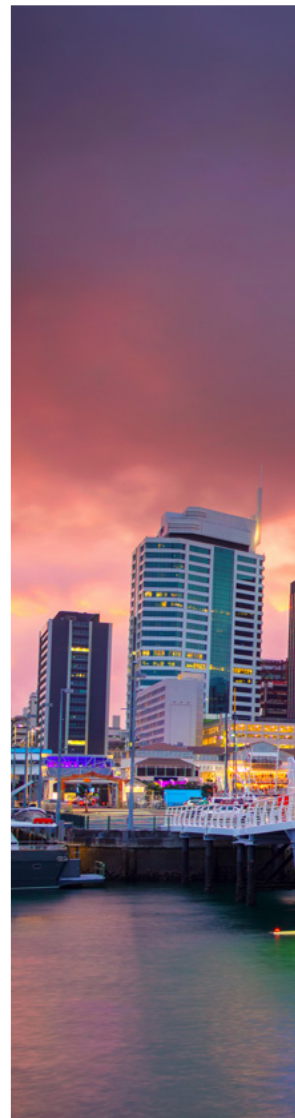

# World Cruise?


---

- » It is an extended cruise that visits dozens of ports in global destinations.
  - » It may be a full trip around the world or focus on certain continents (at least 3).
  - » The most popular World Cruises last approximately 3 to 6 months.
- » Itineraries are designed to include more overnight port calls and late night stays in key destinations.
  - » World Cruises are often designed to visit ports where UNESCO World Heritage sites are accessible, such as the Sydney Opera House, the Taj Mahal or other sought-after destinations.

## Ship Size

Cruise ship size can greatly impact your World Cruise experience. Smaller ships equate to a more intimate sailing experience and can slip into more secluded ports, often docking in the heart of a city. Larger ships provide more onboard activities and entertainment.

## Types of Fares

World Cruise fares range from completely all-inclusive to a more traditional fare, with some cruise lines ranging in between. This can lead to a difference of thousands of dollars in what your reservation costs but also lead to a vastly different onboard experience, in terms of what you pay for once on board. Your World Cruise consultant can help you analyze the differences.

### All-Inclusive Fares

May Include

- » **FREE** roundtrip air (sometimes first class)
- » **FREE** pre-cruise luxury hotel
- » **FREE** shore excursions
- » **FREE** specialty restaurants
- » **FREE** unlimited beverages, including fine wines and premium spirits
- » **FREE** pre-paid gratuities
- » **FREE** transfers between airport and ship

### Traditional Fares

- » A more affordable base entry onto the World Cruise.
- » Guests decide as they go what they feel is important, such as shore excursions, specialty restaurants or spa services.
- » Gratuities are customary at the end of the cruise; a World Cruise consultant can provide guidelines to guests.





# Visas, Insurance & Inoculations

A World Cruise is a commitment of time and money. That's why you want to make sure you have the proper documents needed to travel and take precautions to ensure your trip goes off without a hitch.

## Visas

---

Visa requirements for a World Cruise will vary depending on the guest's nationality and the destinations on the itinerary.

Each visa may take several weeks to acquire. There may also be a fee associated with the process.

## Inoculations

---

A travel clinic can recommend precautions and immunizations to help you stay healthy and avoid illnesses specific to regions you may be visiting.

It's also important to plan ahead for any current medications you are on, to ensure you have the proper amount for your trip.

## Insurance

---

Travel insurance is the number one way to protect your travel investment. There are a variety of types, and you will want to select the

one that best fits with any risk factors as well as your general desire to have all of your bases covered while traveling.

Prescription or over-the-counter medicine, beauty and personal hygiene products, extra pair of eyeglasses, pop-up laundry basket, stain treatment and power strip for electronics
- 4** Personal Stateroom Décor to Make You Feel at Home
  - » Photos of beloved people or pets
  - » A world map to mark off destinations as you visit them
- 5** A Worthwhile Project

# Programs

---

Shore tours allow you to visit a destination more in depth. It may be a relaxing trip to the beach, a wine tasting with sweeping views of the vineyard, a guided tour of a medieval castle, or any number of other options that bring the destination to life.

When you select a shore tour (also known as a shore excursion), aside from having a great experience, you want the peace of mind knowing you are working with a reliable tour operator and that you will return to the ship on time. 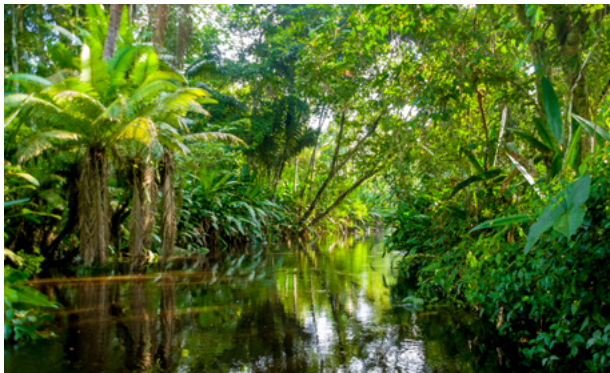

This is a comprehensive, optional tour of some of Southern Africa's most treasured destinations, arranged by Cruise Specialists' Shore Excursion Manager. Cruise Specialists guests leave the ship for 5 days and embark on this exclusive, fully-guided tour, which includes flights, deluxe hotel, most meals, and countless memorable experiences. A Cruise Specialists Voyage Host accompanies the guests the entire 5 days.

After departing the ship in Durban with their host, guests are introduced to their English-speaking guide and board a flight to Johannesburg. The first day includes a tour of the former home of Nelson Mandela, lunch at a local restaurant and accommodations at a sophisticated boutique hotel.

On day two, guests fly to Livingstone, Zambia, then on to a luxurious 5-star hotel where they will stay for 3 nights. There are uninterrupted views of the Zambezi River from the hotel grounds. Guests board a train to enjoy a ride through the Mosi-oa-Tunya Game Park, including a fine dining experience before returning to the hotel.

A highlight of the third day is a 2-hour sunset cruise on the Zambezi. The next day includes a trip to Botswana for additional game viewing in Chobe National Park. The final day guests receive a guided tour of the amazing Victoria Falls. After departing the falls, they are personally escorted back to Johannesburg for a flight to Cape Town where they rejoin the cruise ship to continue the World Cruise.

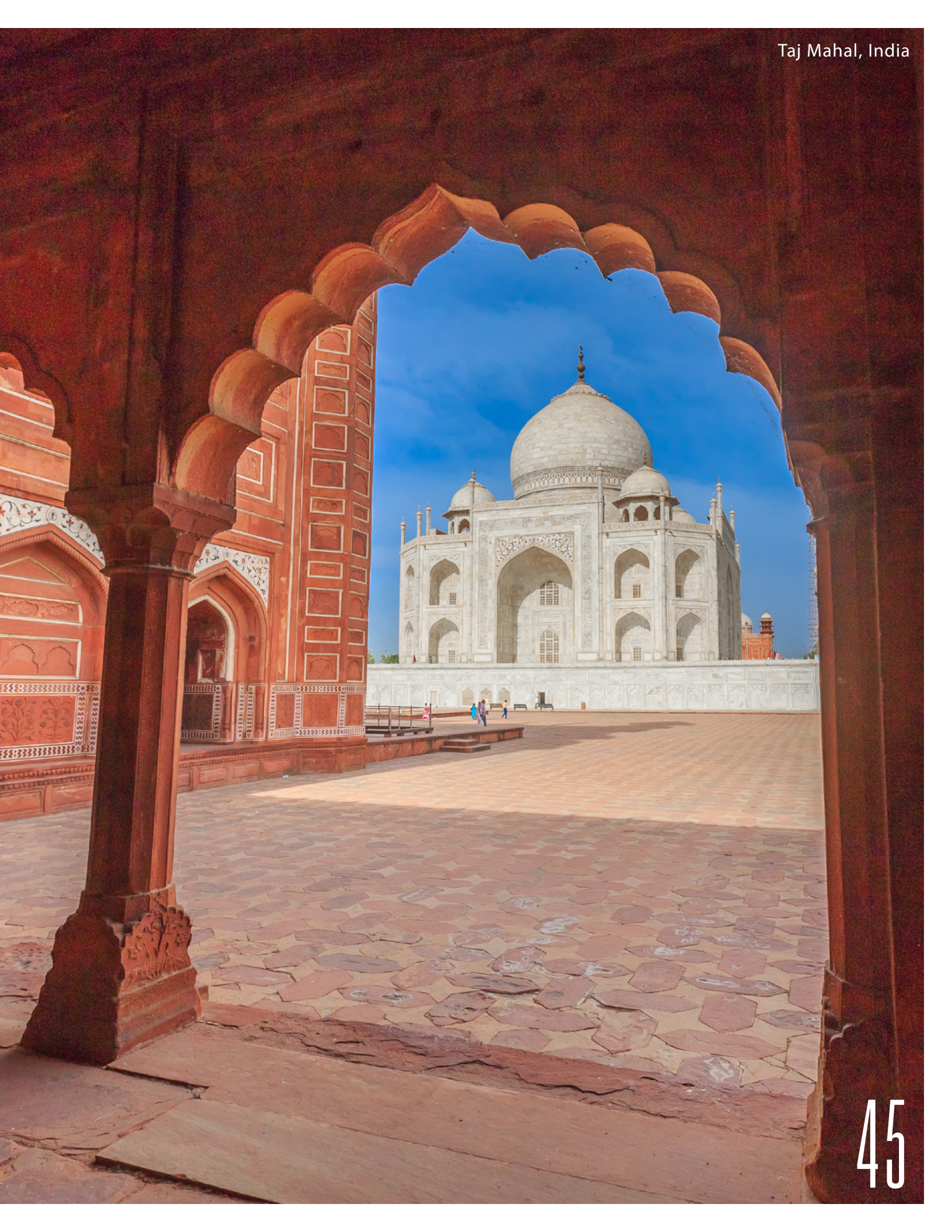

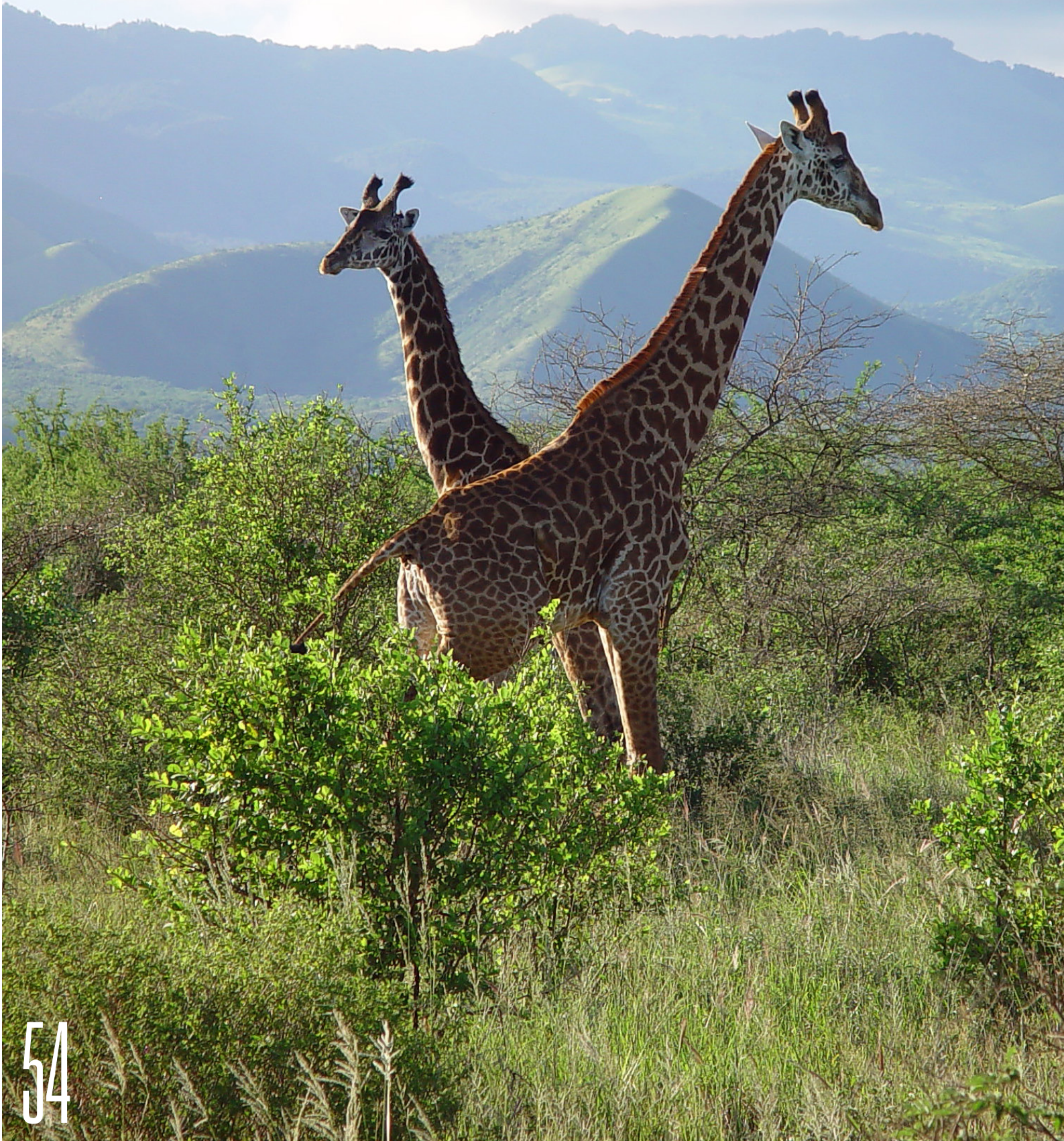
